

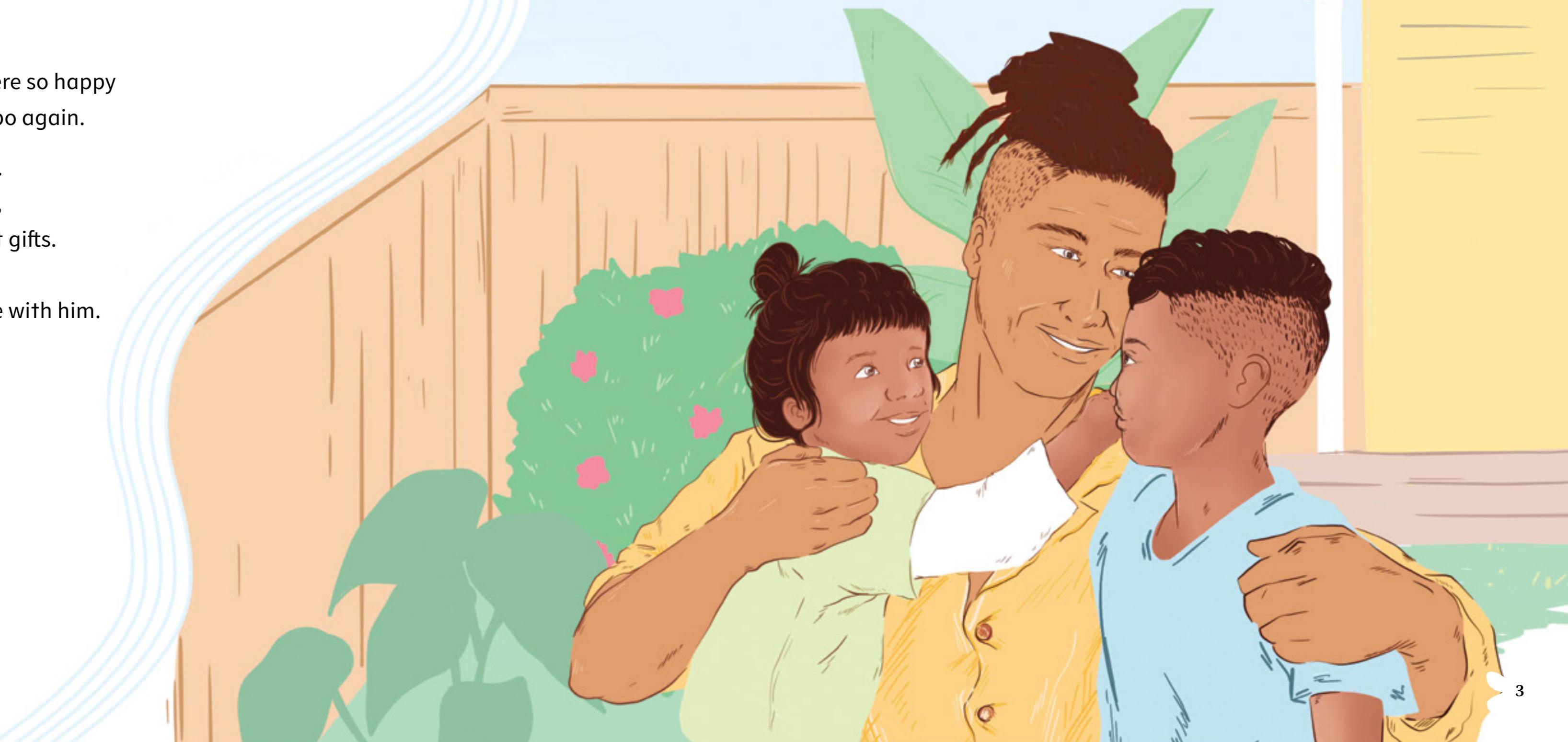

said Uncle Filipo.

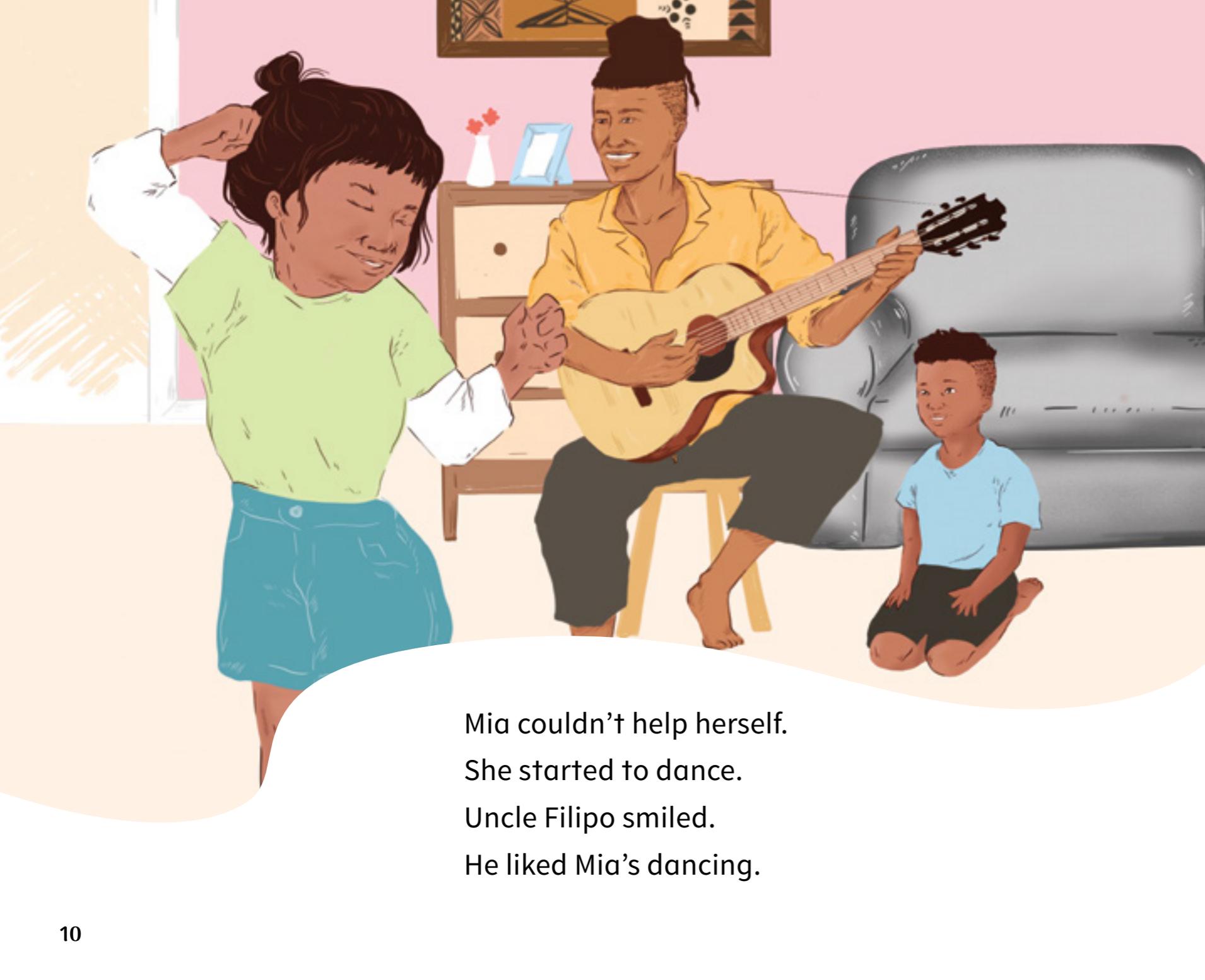
“Can we help?” asked Mia.
